When placed on the floor, the legs are locked down by the mechanism.

This seat must be attached to a vertical surface using suitable fixings appropriate to the type of surface and loading conditions to be applied.


Adjust support legs ensuring that both legs sit firmly on a flat surface, (maximum 1 in 40 shower base slope), when placed in the down position. Curved surfaces such as corners of bathtubs are not acceptable. Stainless steel fixings are recommended.


Mounting Hole Dimensions

Shower Seat Use
