# **Toilet Seat Fixing Instructions**

## Please read these instructions before use and retain for future reference.

**Tools required** 

Adjustable spanner or pliers

Crosshead screwdriver

#### **Contents**

- 1 Toilet seat
- 2 Plastic washers
- 2 Domed washers
- 2 Rubber washers
- 2 Fixing bolts
- 2 Plastic wing nuts

## <u>Safety</u>

Never stand on the lid or ring of your toilet seat – for example when decorating the bathroom. Check regularly to ensure that the nuts are still tight.

#### **Assembly & Fixing Instructions**

- 1. Before fitting the toilet seat, the hinges will need to be adjusted to fit the toilet bowl.
- 2. Loosen the locking screw shown in Fig.1. This will allow the hinge plates to be rotated and adjust the distance between the fixing bolts.
- 3. Insert the fixing bolts into the central threaded hole and LOOSELY tighten.
- 4. Place the seat onto the toilet bowl ensuring that the fixing bolts pass through the holes at the back of the bowl.
- 5. Rotate the hinge plates until the toilet seat is central on the toilet bowl.
- 6. If the fixing bolts are still too close together for the holes in toilet bowl, or the lid and seat will not stay up, then repeat steps 4 & 5 with the fixing bolts fitted in outer threaded hole.
- 7. Having centred the toilet seat, carefully remove it from the toilet bowl and fully tighten the locking screws and fixing bolts.
- 8. Place the plastic washers over the fixing bolts and reposition the seat onto the toilet bowl as before.
- 9. Slide the domed washers and rubber washers over fixing bolts, fit and securely tighten the wing nut.

#### Note

• If the wing nut is not fully tightened the toilet seat will move around on the toilet bowl.

## **Care Instructions**

- Clean all surfaces with a damp cloth and mild soap solution. Do not scrub or use any other substance containing abrasives since these substances will scratch the surface.
- Do not use bleach or cleaning materials containing bleach.
- Failure to clean the hinges over a long period will result in the hinges discolouring. Chrome hinges can usually be restored using a metal polish.
- It is recommended the wing nuts are tightened periodically as may loosen over time from use.





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
